What will the interview process entail for trainee patent attorneys?

Our annual trainee recruitment cycle takes place between June and December each year, with a start date of the following autumn. Our application process is comprised of the following stages:

- Submission of a brief online application form and CV.
- Completion of short pre-recorded video interview, including motivational, strengths-based and technical questions.
- First stage interview, where you will typically meet with a partner and senior associate from the relevant practice area. You'll also have the opportunity to have an informal conversation with some of our current trainees. There will be some pre-interview exercises, and you will be asked to provide a sample of your technical written work. Depending on the practice area you have applied to, there may also be some practical exercises to complete on the day of your interview.
- Final interview, where you will meet all partners from the relevant practice group.

Can I apply for a trainee vacancy if I require a work permit?

We possess a Tier 2 sponsor license and will treat all applications on an individual basis
